

**Mold:** [LF249 Snowman Flakes Ornament](#)

**Frit:** COE96

**Powder (F1):**

- Moss Translucent
- Flame Opal
- Orange Opal
- Black
- Mariner Blue Opal

**Fine (F2):**

- White
- Sky Blue Transparent
- Clear

**Medium (F3):**

- White

**Coarse (F5):**

- Clear

## Other Glass:

**Stringers:**

- Red Opal
- Olive Green Opal

**Sheets:**

- Clear Iridescent

## Placement Order:

**Ornament Top, Scarf, and Mitten Bottoms:**

Alternate Red Opal/Olive Green Opal stringers, then back with Moss Translucent

**Mittens, Hat Stripe, Cheek Blush, and Around Post:** Flame Opal

**Carrot Nose:** Orange Opal

**Eyes, Mouth, Eyebrows, and Hat:** Black

**Snowman:** Fine White

**Large Snowflakes:** Mariner Blue Opal

## Instructions:

Begin with stringer placement as described above. Pointed tweezers make placement easier, and the ridges in the mold help hold them in place. Lengths don't need to be exact, as Moss backing will fill in any gaps.

After stringers, continue to fill in details as shown above. Make sure hat has plenty of frit. Once all details are filled, lightly sprinkle the Sky Blue around the sky and dust everything with the Fine Clear.

Cut a 3" diameter circle of the Clear Iridescent sheet glass and place irid-side down on top of the Clear frit. Sprinkle a few pieces of Medium White as snow, and fill with Coarse Clear to the final fill weight of 130g.

Fire to a **Full Fuse**. After firing and cooling, highlight smaller snowflakes with a Liquid Silver Paint Pen.
